Subj: SD Amateur Radio Directory

As part of the upcoming South Dakota hamfest, a directory of SD hams is being put together. The directory will be similar in format to the "Who's Who in South Dakota Hamdom" directory that was published by Norm Goehring WAØPNB and Ross Massingale WØNEO in 1970.

Some guidelines:

biography: - approximately 100 words describing yourself and your interests
- emailed: in .txt format, or by mail: hand-written, typed, or any other convenient format

photo: - passport-photo size, black & white or color. All photos will appear in the directory in B&W
- if emailed: .jpg or any other common PC format
- if you're in a group photo, indicate which one "is you" and we will cut & paste
